Questions:

1. REVIEW: Summarize what you learned the following:
 - a. 1:1-6
 - b. 1:7-6:15.
 - c. Chapters 7-8
 - d. Chapters 9-11
2. REVIEW: Who is "the word of the Lord concerning" and how far in Zachariah does this word extend?
3. REVIEW: How does the Lord describe Himself in 12:1 and why do you think He does so here in this fashion?
4. REVIEW: Describe from 12:1-9 what is going to happen "in that day"
5. From 12:10, what does the Lord say He will pour out, on whom will this be done and when with that will happen? (We will look at this more later)
6. What does the Lord say the purpose or result (i.e. so that...) of this pouring out will be? Make 2 observations.
7. From the following Who did the Jews pierce Him and when?
 - a. 12:10
 - b. Isaiah 53:3-6
