HOW ARE WE TO BEHAVE IN AN UNGODLY WORLD? PART 1: BEHAVIOR IN RELATION TO GOVERNING AUTHORITIES

Submit, obey, honor, pray 1 Peter 2:13-17

- I. CONTINUALLY SUBMIT TO AND OBEY ALL HUMAN AUTHORITY so that Lord might open the door for redemptive opportunities (13-16)
 - A. The command to be obeyed: <u>Submit</u> to every human institution (13-14, Titus 3, Rom. 13)
 - B. The reasoning to be remembered: <u>Submit</u> because the Lord uses our obedience to silence and save unbelievers (15)
 - 1. For the Lord's sake (13)
 - 2. God has instituted governing authorities (Rom 13)
 - 3. PRIMARILY because He uses our obedience to His will to move in the hearts of nonbelievers (15, 12)
 - C. Do we submit in everything? (Daniel, Acts 5)
 - D. A warning to be heeded: Our freedom in Christ does not free us to sin (i.e. reject or dishonor earthy authorities, but it frees us to obey and serve the Lord (16)
- II. SUBMIT WITH THE RIGHT ATTITUDE: HONORING ALL MEN, especially the king, yet not over elevating above brothers in Christ and God (17)
- III. PRAYING FOR ALL, especially governing authorities (1 Tim. 2:1-6)
