We should be eagerly and mindfully awaiting His Son's return from the heavens (10a) |
|      | B. As we await Jesus, we need to be mindful that His victory over sin, death and Satan is the basis for our deliverance from the same (10a).  |
|      | C. As we await Jesus, we need to be mindful that He is the one who rescues us from God's coming wrath for our sin, individually and corporately (10b).  |
