HOW DO WE KNOW GOD'S WORD IS AT WORK IN US? THE THESSALONIAN'S EXAMPLE: PART 1

1 Thessalonians 2:14-16

- I. THEIR WELCOME OF THE WORD BROUGHT TEMPORAL SUFFERING from their own people, just like Jewish believers received from theirs (14-16)
 - A. **These Thessalonian brethren** became imitators of their Jewish brethren, in that they **also suffered in the same way** at the hands of their own countrymen (14)
 - B. The nature of their suffering, as illustrated through the Jewish persecutors (15-16)
 - 1. **They oppose Christ** The Word incarnate: They killed the Lord Jesus (15a)
 - 2. They oppose those who impart the Word of God (15b)
 - a) They killed the prophets
 - b) The persecuted Paul and his companions
 - 3. Although they do things in God name, they are not pleasing to God but hostile to all men because **they hinder those from speaking the saving Gospel** (15b-16a)
 - 4. **God's wrath is upon them** to the utmost (16b)
