HOW CAN WE STAND FIRM IN THE MIDST OF SUFFERING? PART 1: ENDURING REAL THREATS TO OUR FAITH IN THE LORD 1 Thessalonians 3:1-5

I. REMEMBER GOD USES HIS WORD THROUGH HIS SERVANTS TO STRENGTHEN AND ENCOURAGE US AS TO THE FAITH: Out of great concern, Paul sacrificially sent Timothy to strengthen and encourage them in their faith (1-2)

- II. REALIZE THERE ARE REAL DANGERS TO OUR STANDING FIRM IN OUR FAITH IN JESUS: Paul was very concerned for the Thessalonians faith amid their suffering and temptation, so he sent Timothy to strengthen and encourage them in their faith (3-5)
 - A. Amid suffering they were in danger of being emotionally carried away through a lack of biblical knowledge (3-4)
 - 1. So, God sends His Word so that we will not be emotionally carried away when suffering hits (3a)
 - 2. ...Because we are destined for temporal suffering, which was predicted and did come (3b-4)
 - B. Amid suffering they were in danger of yielding to the tempter's temptation to not to trust Christ and to see those who bring the Word wrongly, thus the Word's work in them would be in vain (5)

(We will look at verses 6-13 more deeply next time)

III. RECEIVE THE WORD by those sent AND RESPOND IN FAITH: Timothy reports back the good news of their faith and love, as evidenced by the Thessalonians thoughts toward and desire to see Paul and his companions (6-8)
