DAY 1: Light out of Darkness Genesis 1:2-5

- I. REVIEW & PRELIMINARY QUESTIONS
  - A. Context and review of Genesis 1:1
  - B. Creation theories we should investigate with Scripture
    - 1. What about the Gap Theory (Gen 1:2, Isaiah 45:18, 1John 1:5... Romans 5:12)
    - 2. What about the Day-Age Theory (Gen 2:1-4, 5-23, Heb 4, Psalm 90, 2Pet 3)
- II. GOD REVEALS THE INITIAL CREATED STATE OF THE EARTH: It was uninhabitable and dark and the Spirit of God was over like a protective parent (1:2)
- III. GOD SPEAKS PHYSICAL LIGHT INTO EXISTENCE: God begins to prepare the earth for habituation (1:3-5)
  - A. God speaks and it is done: Then God said "Let there be light" and there was light (3)
  - B. God assigns moral value: And God saw that the light was good (4a)
  - C. God begins to order by giving light and darkness its place: and God separated the light from the darkness. (4b)
  - D. **God gives meaning:** And God called the light day, and the darkness He called night. (5a)
  - E. **Day 1 is completed:** And there was evening and there was morning, one day (5b)
