HOW CAN WE FIND TRUE REST?

A Look at the Seventh Day Genesis 2:1-3

- I. UNDERSTAND THE MEANING OF THE SABBATH IN GENESIS: By the seventh day, God completed and ceased His creative work and then blessed and set apart the seventh day (2:1-3)
 - A. The Heavens and Earth and all in them were completed (1)
 - **B.** By the seventh day, **God completed the work He did** (2a)
 - **C.** By the seventh day, **God ceased from all His Work he did** (2b)
 - **D.** God blesses and sets apart the seventh day because in it He ceased from all His work He made in creating (3)

 - 4. Given for man's benefit: a gracious provision of physical rest and refreshment (Ex 23:12, Mk. 2:27-28)
 - 5. Given as a sign of the covenant between Israel and God. (Ex 31:13-17)
 - C. The Sabbath's Corresponding New Covenant Reality (Col. 2:13-17, Heb. 4)
