WHAT DOES A LIFE MASTERED BY SIN LOOK LIKE? THE WAY OF CAIN Genesis 4:9-16

I.	THOSE MASTERED BY SIN DO NOT ACKNOWLEDGE THEIR CULPABILITY
	WHEN CONFRONTED BY THE LORD THROUGH HIS WORD: God gives Cain
	a chance to repent but Cain lies and dodges responsibility (9)

- II. THOSE MASTERED BY SIN DO NOT FEAR GOD AND THUS ARE IGNORANT OF HIS OMNISCIENCE AND JUSTICE: God reveals to Cain He knows about Abel's murder and it calls for justice (9-10)
 - A. Cain thought God wouldn't know (9)
 - B. But God does see all: Abel's blood cries for justice (10)
- III. THOSE MASTERED BY SIN HAVE SELFISH REMORSE WHEN CAUGHT, YET ARE NOT REPENTANT FOR THEIR SIN: Cain experiences God's Justice and again rejects His grace (11-15)
 - A. God's Justice Revealed: No escaping from Divine judgment (11-14)
 - 1. Cain's sentence (11-12)
 - 2. His reaction: Self-pity, self-centeredness, self-preservation (13-14)
 - B. God's Grace Manifest: Still yet more time to repent (15)

IV. THOSE MASTERED BY SIN ARE SEPARATED FROM GOD (16)
