- D. Enosh begat Kenan (9-11)
- E. Kenan begat Mahalalel (12-14)
- F. Mahalalel begat Jared (15-17)
- G. Jared begat Enoch (18-20)
- H. Enoch begat Methuselah (21-24)
- I. Methuselah begat Lamech (25-27)
- J. Lamech begat Noah (28-31)
- K. Noah begat Shem, Ham and Jepheth (32)

# II. WHAT DOES IT ALL MEAN? Some important observations and their significance in context

- A. 4:26 sets the stage for a vastly different line (Seth's vs Cain's)
- B. **Seth was according to Adams Image** and likeness (3)
- C. Ages given **center around a certain son born**, although all had other sons and daughters born (4,7,10,13,16,21-22,26,30)
- D. **All died but Enoch**, who was translated (5,8,11,14,17,20,23-24,27 31)
- E. There is no focus on accomplishments, but on faith and walk with the Lord (Ch 4, 5:21-32)
  - 1. Two vastly different Enoch's and Lamech's are presented (21-32)
  - 2. Enoch and Noah are mentioned Hebrews 11 and both declared His Word in the context of an evil world (2Pet 2;5, Jude 14)
