Genesis 5:21-32

- I. *Review:* **UNDERSTAND THERE ARE BUT ONLY TWO WAYS TO WALK (Examples from Cain's line vs Seth's)**

- II. **FROM ENOCH'S EXAMPLE, WE SEE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR AND THE RESULT OF TRULY WALKING WITH GOD (21-24, Heb. 11:5-6, Jude 14-15)**
 - A. **THE REQUIREMENTS FOR WALKING WITH GOD: Faith in Him and His Word (21-24, Heb. 11:5-6, Jude 14-15)**
 - 1. What does it mean **to walk with God**?

 - 2. We must walk **by faith in Him and what He has said** (Hebrews 11:1-5, Jude 14-15, Col 2:6)

 - B. **THE RESULTS OF WALKING WITH GOD BY FAITH (21-24, Heb. 11:5-6, Jude 14-15)**
 - 1. Genuine Faith will manifest **in holy obedience to His Word** (1John 1:5-7, 2:3-6)

 - 2. We are then **pleasing** to God (Heb. 11:5-6)

 - 3. **Deliverance from God' wrath and thus Eternal life** with Him (21-24, Heb. 11:5-6, Jude 14-15)

- III. **METHUSELAH'S EXAMPLE:** In the midst of an evil world, his life typifies the patience of God (25-27)
- IV. **LAMECH'S EXAMPLE:** In the midst of an evil world, by faith he believed the promise of God (28-31)
- V. **AN INTRO INTO NOAH'S EXAMPLE:** In the midst of an evil world, He walked with God (32, 6:1-9)
