THE LORD'S RESPONSE TO MAN'S SIN GRIEF EXPRESSED, JUDGMENT DECLARED AND GRACE DISPENSED Genesis 6:4-8

- I. Review: THE LORD DECLARES HIS PATIENT STRIVING WITH SINFUL MAN WILL END SOON AND HIS JUDGMENT WILL COME (1-3)
 - A. Man's great wickedness is illustrated by beautiful women who appear to have willingly cohabitated with demons, who left their abode, following their own wicked lusts (1-2)
 - B. The Lord responds to man's intense sin with a declaration of assured coming judgment (3)
- II. THE LORD, GRIEVED OVER MAN'S GREAT WICKEDNESS, PRONOUNCES A WORLDWIDE JUDGMENT (4-7)
 - A. **Man's wickedness manifest** in the offspring of the unholy union of the sons of God and the daughters of men: These were famous the mighty men (4)
 - B. **The Lord**, seeing man's great sin, is grieved and sorry He made man (5-6)
 - 1. The Lord observes man's corrupt actions arising from a continually corrupt heart (5)
 - 2. Because of man's sin, the Lord was sorry He created man and grieved in His heart (6)
 - C. Because of holy grief and sorrow, arising from observing man's intense wickedness, the Lord pronounces a worldwide judgment to come (7)
- III. IN CONTRAST, THE LORD BESTOWS HIS SAVING GRACE ON NOAH (8)
