HOW ARE WE WHO WALK BY FAITH TO RESOLVE CONFLICT?

Learning from Abraham's example of faith Genesis 13:5-18

I.	BE WALKING RIGHTLY WITH THE LORD BEFORE CONFLICT HITS (13:1-4, 18)
II.	REALIZE CONFLICT AFFECTS THOSE AROUND US: Abraham and Lot were blessed the land could not sustain their livestock so strife arose between their herdsmen (5-7)
III.	YIELD OUR RIGHTS FOR THE SAKE OF THE RELATIONSHIP AND TRUST THE LORD: For the sake of the relationship, Abraham graciously yields to Lot, giving him the choice of land (8-9)
IV.	REALIZE THERE ARE SUBTLE, YET INCREASING CONSEQUENCES WHEN YOU GET YOUR WAY AND WALK BY SIGHT: Lot's poor choice has subtle yet great consequences (10-13)
V.	In contrast, UNDERSTAND WHEN YOU YIELD AND WALK BY FAITH, YOU ULTIMATELY WILL NEVER LOSE ANYTHING OF TRUE VALUE: Abraham is blessed as God reiterates His promises and then he worships in response (14-18)
