- II. ABRAM VICTORIOUSLY RESCUES LOT by wisely pursuing and defeating the enemy kings (13-16)
 - A. Abram hears of Lot being taken captive and goes in pursuit (13-14)
 - B. Abram wisely fights, defeats and brings back all the goods, Lot, his possessions, the women and people (14-16)
- III. THE TEST OF VICTORY: After the victory, in response to royal recognition, Abram exhibits discernment and worship in the context of faith (17-24)
 - A. Two kings come to Abram; a wicked and worldly Sodomite king and Melchizedek, a priest and king of righteousness and peace (17-20a)
 - 1. After Abram returned from his victory, the king of Sodom comes to meet him at the valley of Shaveh (17)
 - 2. Melchizedek, King of Salem and Priest of the Most High God met Abraham and blessed him, revealing the Lord won the victory for Abram (18-20a, Hebrews 7:1)
 - B. Abram responds in faith, worshiping by giving to the Lord and then refusing to receive booty from the ungodly king of Sodom (18b-24)
