HOW CAN WE OVERCOME OUR FEARS? Learning from Abraham's faith Genesis 15:1-6

- I. LET HIM SPEAK TO YOU THROUGH HIS WORD: The Lord God reassures fearing Abram with His Word (1-5)
 - A. After these things? What things? (1a)
 - B. **The Word of the Lord came to Abram** commanding him to not fear because He is a shield to him and will be rewarded greatly (1b)
 - 1. The command: Do not fear
 - 2. Why? The Lord God is a shield to him and will greatly reward him
 - C. Abraham responds with a focus on the Lord's previous promise, wondering about his heir in the flesh who has not been given yet (2-3)
 - D. The Lord God responds that one from Abrams own body shall be his heir and then He visibly and verbally reminds him of His previous promise (4-5)
- II. SIMPLY BELIEVE WHAT HE SAYS: Abraham believed in the Lord it was reckoned to him as righteousness (6, Rom. 4, Gal. 3. James 2)
 - A. Some important questions:
 - 1. When was Abraham saved?
 - 2. How was he saved?
 - 3. What do the terms believe, reckoned and righteousness mean?
