HOW SHOULD WE RESPOND TO A LOVED ONE'S DEATH IN CHRIST? FAITH IN THE MIDST OF DEATH Genesis 23:1-20

- I. REMEMBER WE ARE TEMPORARY SOJOURNERS ON THIS EARTH: Sarah dies in faith in the land of promise (1-2a, 4, Hebrews 11:13-16)
 - A. Sarah dies in the land of Canaan as a sojourner (1-2a, Hebrews 11:13-16)
 - B. Sarah died in faith looking for a better county, a heavenly one (1-2a, Hebrews 11:13-16)
 - C. We too are sojourners who can be assures of what happens to us in Christ when we die (1 Peter 1, 1Thes 4)
- II. RESPOND IN FAITH BY LETTING YOUR GREIF AND ACTIONS TO BE TEMPERED BY THE SURE PROMISES OF GOD: Abraham responds in faith to Sarah's death by initially mourning then seeking to possess a burial site in the land of promise (2b-20, Hebrews 11:13-16)
 A. Abraham mourns (2b)
 - B. Abraham as a sojourner manifests faith in seeking to possess a burial site in the land from to bury Sarah (3-20)
 - Abraham seeks to secure a burial site from the sons of Heth (Canaanites) (3-9)
 - 2. Ephron the Hittite politely and shrewdly deals with Abraham(10-15)
 - 3. Abraham pays the price and the land and cave in Canaan are deeded to him for a burial site and he buries Sarah there (16-20)
