## LEARNING FROM THE LORD PROTECTION OF JACOB Genesis 31:17-55

I.	OBEY THE LORD'S WORD: Jacob obeys and departs for Canaan (Review 1-16)
	17-18)

- II. UNDERSTAND THE LORD SOVEREIGNLY PROTECTS HIS CHILDREN and THUS TRUST IN HIM (17-42)
  - A. **Do not fear man or circumstances:** While obeying the Lord, Jacob reacts out of fear and secretly departs for Canaan (17-21, 31)
  - B. Realize no one can harm you apart from Lord allowing it for our ultimate good: Laban sets out in hot pursuit for his household idols yet God intervenes behind the scenes to protect Jacob from harm (22-24)
  - C. Realize God graciously protects us even in spite of our sin (25-42)
    - 1. Laban accuses Jacob of stealing his idols, searches and does not find them (25-35)
    - 2. Jacob finally lets loose, revealing his faithful service, Laban's wickedness and the Lord's faithful blessing and protection (36-42)
- III. PRAISE AND WORSHIP THE LORD FOR THE RESULTS: Laban proposes peace, Jacob accepts and worships the Lord (43-55)
  - A. Laban amazingly proposes a peace treaty and Jacob accepts (43-53)
  - B. Jacob worships and Laban leaves, never to heard of again in Scripture (54-55)
