THE MESSIAH KING BEGINS HIS EARTHLY MINISTRY: THE BAPTISM OF JESUS Matthew 3:13-17

I. JESUS ARRIVES FROM GALILEE TO BE BAPTIZED AND JOHN TRIES TO PREVENT HIM (13-14)

A. Jesus arrives to be baptized by John (13)

B. John, recognizing He is the Lamb of God (Jn. 1:29), attempts to prevent it (14)

II. THE PURPOSE OF HIS BAPTISM REVEALED IN JESUS' RESPONSE: Permit it, it is right for us to fulfill all righteousness (15)

- A. Permit it...let it happen now
- B. Permit it ...because it is right for us (John and Jesus) to fulfill all righteousness (11a)
- C. But what is the purpose? The sinless Son identifying with sinful man, ultimately to bring about righteousness
- III. THE PURPOSE OF HIS BAPTISM REVEALED IN THE RESPONSE FROM HEAVEN: Public, visible anointing for His redemptive work and audible approval of Him (16-17)

A. Immediately after the Heavens were opened (16a)

- B. Immediately after there was a visible anointing of Jesus by the Spirit for His redemptive work (16b)
- C. The Fathers affirmation of the Son: Beloved and well pleasing (17)
