WHAT DOES GOD HAVE TO SAY ABOUT DIVORCE?

KING JESUS REVEALS TRUE RIGHTEOUSNESS IS A MATTER OF THE HEART
Matthew 5:31-32

- I. JESUS UNVEILS THE JEWS ADULTEROUS HEARTS BY ADDRESSING THEIR WRONG VIEW OF DIVORCE (31-32)
 - A. WHAT THE JEWS HAD HEARD CONCERNING DIVORCE: For basically any reason, it is ok to divorce if you give a certificate of divorce (31)
 - **B. WHAT THEY SHOULD OF KNOWN FROM THE OLD TESTAMENT** (Misc passages)
 - 1. God's intent for marriage (Gen 2, Matt19, Eph 5)
 - 2. **God's view of divorce**: Hated but permitted under certain circumstances (Duet 24:1-4, Malachi 2:16, Matt 19:3-9)
 - C. WHAT JESUS SAYS CONCERNING DIVORCE: Your view brings about adultery, except in the case of immorality (32)
 - 1. Everyone who divorces cause adultery to be committed (32, Mark 10:1-2)
 - 2. The exception: You're guilty, except in the case of a spouse's sexual immorality, which implies remarriage is permitted (32, cf 19:6)
 - 3. The implication in context: You're guilty, worthy of hell (cf 27-30)
- II. FURTHER NEW TESTAMENT TEACHING ON DIVORCE AND REMARRIAGE
 - A. You can divorce and remarry if a unbelieving spouse leaves (1Cor 7:10-16, 27-28)
 - B. What about Romans 7, which speaks of remarriage in case of death alone?
- III. WHAT DO I DO IF I HAVE SINNED in the matter of Divorce?
