

HOW ARE WE TO PRAY? Part 5
Jesus reveals we are to pray in a way that which glorifies God
Matthew 6:11-15

- I. Review: PRAY IN A MANNER THAT GLORIFIES OUR GOD by addressing Him rightly (9a)

- II. Review: PRAY IN A MANNER THAT GLORIFIES OUR GOD by desiring His exaltation in position and ultimate purpose to be fulfilled (9b-10)
 - A. PRAY FOR HIS EXALTATION: “Let Thy Name be hallowed” (9b)

 - B. PRAY FOR HIS PURPOSES TO BE FULFILLED: Petition for His future Kingdom to Come and His Will be done now (10)

- III. PRAY IN A MANNER THAT GLORIFIES OUR GOD by humbly submitting our genuine needs to Him which brings Him glory (11-13)
 - A. **Petition for daily sustenance:** God is glorified when exhibit humble dependence

 - B. **Petition for forgiveness:** God is glorified when we humbly acknowledge our need for forgiveness as exemplified by our ability to forgive (12)

 - C. **Petition for deliverance from great spiritual danger:** God is glorified when we dependently realize in prayer only He delivers us from temptation and evil (13)

- IV. UNDERSTAND HE BASIS FOR PRAYER THAT IS HEARD: His forgiveness, which is evidence by our ability to forgive (14-15)
