- I. WHERE YOUR TREASURE IS REVEALS WHERE YOUR HEART IS (19-21)
 - A. Jesus commands us not to lay up temporal fleeting treasures on earth (19)
 - 1. The Pharisee's view of money and possessions (Luke 16:14)
 - 2. Old Testament warnings concerning wicked heart attitudes in relation to wealth (Duet, Prov.)
 - 3. Is Jesus advocating poverty? Is it a sin to be wealthy? (Various passages)
 - 4. What then is Jesus saying? (6:19)
 - B. Jesus commands us in contrast to lay up eternal treasures in heaven (20)
 - C. The location of our treasure reveals our spiritual heart condition (21)
- II. THE EYE AS AN ILLUSTRATION OF THE HEART: it is either clear or evil (22-23)
- III. A SOBERING EXHORTATION: Don't be deceived "no one can serve two masters" (24)
 - A. The absolute fact: No one can serve two masters (24a)
 - B. The reason: Your love of and holding on to money will cause you to hate and despise Christ (24b)
 - C. The conclusion: You cannot serve God and money (24c)
