HOW CAN WE SURVIVE TRIALS WHICH WILL COME FOR FOLLOWING JESUS?

Matthew 8:23-27

- I. UNDERSTAND TRIALS ARE COMING WHEN YOU FOLLOW AND OBEY HIM: Jesus' disciples are thrust into a life and death trial for obeying and following Him (23-24)
 A. Trials are coming: The disciples are lead into a great storm (23-24a)
 - **B.** God often uses storms to symbolize our great trials (various OT passages)
 - **C.** Understand the difference between trials for following and obeying versus His discipline for our disobedience (23-24a, Hebrews 12:4-11)

- II. DON'T BE A SPIRITUAL COWARD IN TRIALS, LEARN TO COMPLETELY TRUST CHRIST: Jesus rebukes these cowardly disciples (24b-26a)
 A. This deadly trial was no concern for Christ: He was asleep (24b)
 - **B.** Learn from the disciples: **Go to Christ, not as a spiritual coward, but as a trusting dependant disciple** (25-26a)
 - 1. What they did right: They believed (a little faith) Jesus could save them (25a)
 - 2. What they did wrong: They were rebuked for being fearful and cowardly thinking they would perish, even with Christ on board (25b-26a)

III. REALIZE JESUS IS IN CONTROL AND SOVEREIGN OVER YOUR TRIAL AND RESPOND RIGHTLY: Jesus turns a GREAT STORM into GREAT CALM (26b-27)
