

## **WHO DID JESUS COME TO SAVE?**

**Jesus came to save sinners!**

Matthew 9:9-13

- I. LEARN FROM WHO JESUS CALLS: Matthew is called to follow Him (9A)**
  
- II. LEARN FROM MATTHEWS RESPONSE which reveals he got saved (9b-10)**
  - A. Matthew obeys the Lord and leaves all (9b)**
  
  - B. Matthew introduces his friends and associates the Jesus (10)**
  
- III. BE WARNED AND LEARN FROM JESUS AUTHORITATIVE REBUKE OF THE SELF RIGHTEOUS, BLIND, HYPOCRITES, WHO DO NOT SEE THEIR NEED FOR REPENTANCE (11-13)**
  - A. The Pharisees self-righteously scoff at Christ**, grumbling to His disciples concerning Jesus' association with sinners... (11)
    - B. Jesus mercifully rebukes the Pharisees** , revealing His call to repentance is to those who recognize their true state as sinners, unlike them (12-13)
      - 1. Jesus illustrates on a human level** that It is the sin sick who need a Savior (12)
  
      - 2. Jesus mercifully rebukes the self righteous** with His Word, by revealing His desire is for a heart change not hypocritical external obedience (13a)
  
      - 3. Jesus authoritatively explains** He came to call (and thus save) those who recognized they are sinners, not the self-righteous (13b)
