## **HOW CAN WE ENDURE PERSCUTION?**

## Learning from our Lord's Commands to His tribulation disciples Matthew 10:17-23

- I. WE MUST UNDERSTAND THE TEXT IN IT'S CONTEXT: While instructing His apostles to be discerning on their first assignment, Jesus transitions into instructions for the His Jewish tribulation disciples (17-23) (Matt 24:1-22, Mark 13:1-20, Luke 21:5-24, Matt 10:23)
- II. UNDERSTAND JESUS IS INSTRUCTING HIS JEWISH TRIBULATION DISCIPLES IN RELATION TO SUFFERING THEY WILL ENCOUNTER FOR OBEYING HIM (17-23)
  - A. They are to understand severe religious, secular and family persecution for obeying Christ will come by men who hate Christ and thus respond rightly (17-21)
    - 1. Saved Jewish disciples will encounter religious persecution from fellow Jews (17)
    - 2. These disciples are not to worry when they are brought before secular government and God will testify through them (18-20)
    - 3. These disciples will be delivered up to death by family (21)
  - B. They are to understand all this persecution is based upon a hatred for Christ (22a)
  - C. They need to know true believe will endure to the end (22b)
  - D. There are to wisely respond to persecution knowing it will end when Christ comes (23)
- III. RECOGNIZE JESUS' INSTRUCTIONS HERE HAVE SECONDARY APPLICATIONS FOR ALL OF HIS DISCIPLES: We must understand persecution is coming, then we must trust Him and discerningly obey because He is working through it for His glory
