HOW CAN WE KEEP FROM COMPROMISING IN MINISTRY?

Learning from our Lord's Commands to His disciples Matthew 10:24-42

I.	WE ARE TO UNDERSTAND WE SERVE HIM THE CONTEXT OF OPPOSITION meant for Him: Jesus reveals His disciples and bondservants will be opposed (24-25)
II.	WE ARE TO FEAR HIM NOT MAN by declaring His truth: Jesus commands His disciples not to fear those who will persecute, but to fear Him, speaking His Word (26-31)
	A. We are not to fear men, but speak His Word because Christ and His truth will be vindicated: All will be revealed (26-27)
	B. We are not to fear men, who at worst can only kill, but rather fear God because He can destroy both body and soul in Hell (28)
	C. Do not fear men, but fear God because He greatly values you (29-31)
III.	WE ARE TO <i>BE ENCOURAGED, YET HEED HIS WARNING</i> : Confess Him, He will confess you. Deny Him, He will deny you (32-33)
	A. An Encouragement not to fear men: Genuine confession of Christ through obedient sharing of His Word reveals a genuine relationship (32)
	B. A Warning to fear God: Denying Christ by not sharing His Word because of fear of men reveals a lack of a true relationship with Christ (33)
