I.	Learn from THE OCCASION IN WHICH JESUS FULFILLS ISAIAH'S PROPHECY: Jesus wisely withdrew from opposition but not from His ministry so as to fulfill God's intended purpose for Him (15-17)
II.	Learn from THE DESCRIPTION OF JESUS IN ISAIAH'S PROPHECY: Jesus is God's beloved, chosen, well pleasing Servant, who accomplishes His will, His way (18-21)
	A. Behold the description of Jesus (18a)1. He is God's chosen Servant (18a)
	2. He is beloved and well pleasing (18a)
	3. He would be anointed and empowered by the Spirit of God (18b)
	B. The description of His ministry (18c-20)1. He will proclaim God's justice through the gospel to the nations (18c)
	2. He will do so without contention or being in-your-face (19)
	 He will graciously minister according to God's timetable, being patient, withholding judgment upon His enemies until justice is thrust forth into victory (20)

C. The result: Gentiles will hope in Him (21)
