THE CLIMAX OF REJECTION Blaspheming the Holy Spirit--Part 1 Matthew 12:22-30

- REJECTION OF CHRIST BEGINS WITH BEING UNCONVINCED, EVEN IN THE MIDST OF CONVINCING PROOF: Jesus heals a demon possessed man the crowd is amazed yet not convinced He is the Messiah (22-23)
- II. REJECTION OF CHRIST CULMINATES IN REJECTION OF HIS SPIRITS' CLEAR REVELATION OF HIM, so as to keep one's lifestyle of sin (religious or irreligious): The Pharisees try to protect their religious positions of power and authority with the multitudes by blaspheming, attributing Jesus' healings to Satan (24)

III. ONLY CHRIST THROUGH HIS WORD UNVEILS THE UNDERLYING WICKED REALITY AND FUTURE DESTINY OF THOSE WHO REJECT HIM (25-30)

A. For the sake of the crowd, Jesus destroys the Pharisees evil illogical and absurd accusation revealing they are on the road to judgment (25-27)

- 1. In light of Gods revelation, there rejection of Christ is illogical (25-26)
- 2. At the core of rejection of Christ is an inconsistent hypocritical bias (27)
- B. Jesus reveals because His irrefutable power is of God, there is no middle ground, you are either for Him or against Him (28-30)
