HOW CAN WE ESCAPE THE DEADLY SNARE OF FALSE TEACHING? A Condemnation of False Teachers and a Warning for True Disciples Matthew 16:1-12

- I. WE MUST UNDERSTAND and ACCEPT GOD'S VIEW OF FALSE TEACHERS...they are blind, evil and spiritually adulterous: Jesus condemns the spiritually blind, evil and adulterous false teachers who are attempting to trap and discredit Him by asking for sign (1-4a, 12)
 - A. The unbelieving Pharisees and Sadducees dispute with Christ seeking to discredit Him by requesting for a sign from heaven (1, Mark 8:11)
 - B. **Jesus, deeply grieved**, refusing to give them their request **unveils their true, evil** and adulterous nature, pointing out their spiritual blindness concerning Him (cannot discern the times) (2-4a, Mark 8:12)
- II. WE MUST UNDERSTAND and HEED OUR LORDS COMMAND TO WATCH OUT AND BEWARE OF THE DEADLY TEACHING OF FALSE TEACHERS: Jesus uses the disciples lack of faith concerning bread to command and warn them concerning the leavened bread, the deadly teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees (4b-12)
 - A. Introductory note: They left for the other side and the disciples forget bread (4b-5)
 - B. Jesus Warns and Commands His disciples to watch out and beware of the leaven (poisonous teaching) of the Pharisees and Sadducees (6)
 - C. Jesus uses the disciples misunderstanding to reveal their little faith and give them right understanding concerning His warning regarding false teaching (7-12)
 - 1. The disciples misunderstand Jesus thinking His warning is about physical bread (7)
 - 2. Jesus graciously reproves and instructs them concerning their lack of faith so that they would understand what He meant (8-11)
 - 3. **The disciple get it:** They realize Jesus was talking about the completely leavened wicked spiritual bread the religious leaders were giving out (teaching) not the physical bread they forgot (12)
