HOW NOT TO BE A TOOL OF THE TEMPTER What do you think about? Matthew 16:20-23

I. PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO GOD'S WILL REVEALED THROUGH GOD'S WORD: Jesus begins to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, suffer, be killed and then rise from the dead on the third day (20-21)

A. Jesus requested Identity was temporally concealed from the multitudes (20)

B. Jesus begins from this point on to show His disciples what He must do: Go to Jerusalem, suffer, be killed, and be raised from the dead on the third day (21)

- II. RECOGNIZE WHEN YOUR DESIRES AND THINKING ARE CONTRARY TO HIS WILL REVEALED IN HIS WORD, THEN REPENT AND RENEW YOUR MIND: Peter foolishly rebukes the Lord and the Lord reproves Peter, revealing his Satanic thinking, which is in opposition to Him (22-23)
 - A. Learn from Peter's negative example as he zealously, yet ignorantly and foolishly rebukes the Lord based on his own desire (22)

B Be taught by our Lords' rebuke of Peter (23)

- 1. Understand how fast one can go from being blessed (cf17) to thinking and acting satanically (23a)
- 2. Know when our thinking is not lined up with God's Word, we are thinking satanically (23a)
- 3. Know when our thinking is not lined up with God's Word, we are a stumbling block to Christ and His will (23b)
