WHO IS THE GREATEST IN CHRIST'S KINGDOM?

Jesus teaches His disciples about true humility
Matthew 18:1-4

- I. UNDERSTAND THE OVERALL CONTEXT OF MATTHEW 18
 - **a.** Jesus reveals the incredible value of His children (1-10)
 - **b.** Jesus thus goes after those who sin (11-14)
 - **c.** The way Jesus seeks after staying sheep is through His Body, the Church (15-20)
 - **d.** Jesus reveals how His Body is to respond if straying sheep repent; Forgive! (21-35)
- II. REALIZE ENTRANCE AND GREATNESS IN HIS KINGDOM COMES THROUGH TOTAL DEPENDENT FAITH IN JESUS as illustrated by a child's humility (1-4)
 - a. WHO IS THE GREATEST? Jesus uses the disciples argument to reveal true greatness in His Kingdom (1, Mark 9)
 - b. HOW DOES ONE ENTER HIS KINGDOM? Jesus reveals you must be converted to enter His Kingdom and illustrates it with a child's humble dependence (2-3)
 - **1. The illustration of a child:** Humble dependent trust (2)
 - **2. The declaration of God**: Unless you are turn (repent) and become like such a child (humbly dependent) you will not enter (3)

c. HOW IS ONE GREAT IN HIS KINGDOM? Jesus reveals, it is the same way you entered...humble dependent faith in Him (4)
