

HOW SHOULD WE EVANGELIZE THOSE WHO ARE SEEKING?
LESSONS ON EVANGELISM FROM JESUS HIMSELF
MATTHEW 19:13-26

- I. REMEMBER THAT ENTRANCE INTO HIS KINGDOM COMES THROUGH REPENTANT, HUMBLE, DEPENDENT FAITH IN JESUS** as illustrated again by children's humility (13-15, 18:1-4)
- II. OBSERVE HOW OUR LORD SHARED HIS GOSPEL AND DO THE SAME:** When asked how to inherit eternal life, Jesus wisely and discerningly reproved the rich rulers' view of Him, exposed sin and then called for repentance and faith in Him (16-21)
- A. Jesus presented His Gospel wisely and lovingly and so should we** (16-21, Mark 10:21)
- B. Jesus used His Word to wisely expose this man's wrong view of Him and his specific sin** and so should we (16-21a)
1. Jesus wisely begins, **confronting this man's faulty view of Him and self** (16-17a)

 2. Jesus, **using His Word**, wisely **confronts this man's specific sin** (17b-21a)
- C. Jesus calls for repentance from sin and complete faith in Him** and so should we (21)
- III. KNOW THAT TRUE SALVATION IS ALL OF GOD NOT OF MAN:** Jesus reveals to His disciples through the man's rejection of Him the impossibility of being saved by man's effort or means but with God alone all things are possible (22-26)
