- I. THE OCCASION FOR THE PARABLE: The rich young ruler, Peters question & Jesus' response (19:27-30)
- II. A SIMPLE PARABLE: Jesus explains in a kingdom parable what He meant by "the first will be last and the last first" (20:1-15)
 - A. Laborer's sought at different times and hired to work. (1-7)
 - B Laborer's summoned to receive their wages (8)
 - C The Surprise: The last paid first and as much as the first (9-10)
 - D. The objection by the first (11-12)
 - E. The owner's gracious explanation reveals He is fair, sovereign and good yet the first are envious prideful grumblers (13-15)
- III. A SUMMARY THAT EXPLAINS: Thus...the first will be la and the last first (16)
- IV. IMPORTANT LESSONS FOR THE DISCIPLES AND TRUE BELIEVER'S
 - **A. Don't see serving Christ as a job deserving of a wage.** Serving is a glorious privilege granted by a gracious God
 - **B. Don't compare your life with others just follow Jesus:** Jesus, a Sovereign, just God has differing will and plans for us in this life
 - C. Acknowledge His blessing in everything He gives: He is good
