HOW TO BE GREAT IN HIS KINGDOM JESUS INSTRUCTS HIS DISCIPLES CONCERNING TRUE GREATNESS USING HIMSELF AS THE PERFECT EXAMPLE Matthew 20:17-28

- I. If you wish to be great...REALIZE THE WORLDS VIEW OF GREATNESS IS TOTALLY OPPOSITE GOD'S VIEW: Jesus uses James and Johns ignorant request for greatness to reveal they are not to have the worlds mindset (17-26)
 - A. Jesus gives a fitting reminder of His imminent suffering, death and resurrection to set the scene (17-19)
 - B. Jesus uses James' and John's grand request to reveal the disciples have a sinful worldly mindset concerning greatness (20-26)
 - 1) An ignorant request and sobering answer (21-23)
 - 2) A telling response (24)
 - 3) A righteous lesson and exhortation (25-26a)
- II. If you wish to be great...BE A HUMBLE OBEDIENT KINGDOM SERVANT LIKE CHRIST WAS: Jesus reveals the mindset of the truly great, exemplified by His own obedient serving unto death (26b-28)

A. In contrast to how the world thinks, Jesus reveals true greatness comes in the context of humble obedient servant hood (26b-27)

B Jesus' glorious example reiterated: He came to serve not be served and to give His life as a ransom for many (28)
