## RENDER TO GOD WHAT IS GOD'S! Lessons from our Lord Jesus' all wise reproof of the wicked leaders concerning God and government Matthew 22:15-22

- I. A QUESTION CONCERNING TAXES DESIGNED TO ENTRAP: The hypocritical wicked hardened Pharisees plot and execute a trick question designed to trap Jesus in His words so that they might then be able to have Him killed (15-17)
  - A. The context ("*Then*"): Jesus had just finished condemning the religious leaders with three parables and they wanted to destroy Him (15a, Matt 21:49, Lk. 20:19)
  - **B.** A wicked plot enacted: The Pharisees then hatch a wicked plot to trip Him up in His words so that they could deliver him to Roman governor (15-17)
    - 1. A wicked plot hatched by wicked people (15-16a, 18)
    - 2. Their truthful flattery used to disarm and entrap (16b)
    - 3. Their trick (loaded) question: "Is it lawful to give Poll tax to Caesar?" (17)
- II. A PERFECTLY WISE ANSWER THAT ALSO REVEALS OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO GOD AND GOVERNMENT: Jesus, knowing their wicked testing, destroys their trap and leaves us an important principle concerning rendering what we owe to government and God (18-22)
  - A. An open rebuke and all wise reproof: Jesus, knowing their evil motives, reproves them outright and with a proverbial saying which says it all (18-21)
  - **B.** A principle established: "...render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are God's." (21, Romans 13, Titus 3, 1 Pet. 2 Misc. passages )
  - **C. An eternally sad response:** They marveled at the wisdom of His reproof of them yet they walked away (22)
