## DO YOU UNDERSTAND THE NEW COVENANT?

Jesus transforms the Old Covenant Passover into the New Covenant Lord's Supper **Matthew 26:26-30** 

- I. JESUS ESTABLISHES THE SYMBOLIC REMEMBRANCE concerning His imminent death (sacrifice) which would initiate and establish the New Covenant, which brought forgiveness of sins (26-29)
  - A. **THE CONTEXT** is the Old Covenant Passover meal on the night He was betrayed (26a)
  - B. **HIS COMMAND:** take eat, ...take drink, in remembrances of Me (26b-27, Luke 22:19-20)
  - C. **THE SYMBOLISM AND THE REALITY**: Jesus is establishing the prophesied New Covenant through His death, which brings about the forgiveness of sins (28, Luke 22, Jeremiah 31:31-34)
    - 1. Bread represents His body given for us (Luke 22)
    - 2. Cup poured out represents His blood poured out for us which establishes the New Covenant bringing forgiveness of sins (28, Luke 22)
    - 3. **The New Covenant Explained** (Jeremiah 31:31-34 and Hebrews 8) (a) Through Christ, we receive a new heart, ready to receive God's Word
      - (b) Through Christ, we enter into a relationship with the living God
      - (c) Through Christ, we have the complete forgiveness of sins
- II. In light of His Imminent death, JESUS ENCOURAGES HIS DISCIPLES AND GIVES THEM AN EXAMPLE (29-30)
  - A. In light of His imminent death Jesus encourages His disciples, revealing they will be together in the Kingdom (29)
  - B. In light of His imminent death Jesus and His disciples worship as they sing a hymn (30)
