## HOW TO AVOID DISASTROUS SPIRITUAL FAILURE? Part 1 LEARNING FROM PETER'S FAILURE Matthew 26:31-35

## I. WE MUST LISTEN TO WHAT GOD SAYS! We are in terrible spiritual danger when we do not truly hear what our Lord says in His Word (31-33)

- A. Jesus predicts all the disciples temporal stumbling because of His arrest, affirming and fulfilling Scripture (31)
- B. Jesus further encourages the disciples, revealing that they will be reunited in Galilee after His resurrection (32)
- C. Peter reveals he has dangerously selective hearing (33)

## II. WE MUST SEE OURSELVES RIGHTLY: We are in terrible spiritual danger when we do not see ourselves rightly (33-35)

- Peter manifests a prideful self-sufficiency that ignores and even contradicts God's Word (33-35)
- B. Peter through His sinful pride (a wrong view of self) became a target for the devil's temptation and fell (Luke 22:31-34, Matt 26:69-75)
