WHAT IS THE GREAT COMMISSION? PART 1 AN OVERVIEW AND IMPORTANT PRELIMINARY QUESTIONS Matthew 28:16-20 part 1

- I. THE CONTEXT (16-18) AND AN OVERVIEW (19-20) of what is called by many "THE GREAT COMMISSION" (16-20)
 - A. **THE DISCIPLES OBEDIENCE:** After His resurrection, Jesus' disciples precede to the mountain He designated in Galilee to meet Him (16)
 - B. A RECOGNITION OF DEITY: Jesus meets His disciples and they respond in Worship but some others doubt, indicating there are more there than just the eleven, including women disciples (17, cf. 28:7 also)
 - C. A COMMAND TO MAKE DISCIPLES BASED UPON HIS ALL ENCOMPASSING AUTHORITY (18-20a)
 - 1. Jesus declares His authority over all (19)
 - 2. Based on the fact Jesus is God and thus has authority over all, He gives His disciples the command... 'having gone, "make disciples of all the nations," by baptizing and teaching all He commanded' (19-20a)
 - D. AN ENCOURAGEMENT FOR THOSE WHO OBEY: In light of His command, Jesus encourages His disciples that He is with them, even to the end of the age (20b)

 - B. To whom do they apply...the eleven, the women and others there too, the individual and/or the church?
