## HOW ARE WE TO DEAL WITH IMPOSSIBLE SITUATIONS? LEARNING FROM NEHEMIAH'S AWESOME EXAMPLE OF PRAYER Nehemiah 1:5-11

I. *Review:* **THE OCCASION FOR NEHEMIAH'S PRAYER:** Nehemiah's prayer arose out of his brokenness over the remnant in Judah and the condition of the wall of Jerusalem (1-4)

## II. THE EXAMPLE OF NEHEMIAH'S PRAYER FOR US TO FOLLOW (5-11)

- A. As you beseech the Lord, <u>BEGIN WITH PRAISE FOR HIS GREATNESS</u>: Nehemiah begins His petition, praising God for His awesome greatness and character, revealing he believed the Lord was far above the situation (5)
- B. <u>BE PERSISITANT IN PRAYER</u> and thus let the Lord work on you: Nehemiah persisted in prayer for four months, which moved his heart to desire to do what God wanted him to do (6a)
- C. <u>BESEECH THE LORD</u> ON BEHALF OF OTHERS AND GOD'S GLORY: Nehemiah's concern for His people and His Name drew him to intercede for them (6a)
- D. <u>HUMBLY CONFESS SIN</u>, especially that WHICH RELATES TO YOUR CIRCUMSTANCE: Nehemiah acknowledged his and Israel's sin brought about the situation and confessed to the Lord (6b-7)
- E. <u>REMIND GOD OF HOW HIS WORD APPLIES</u> TO YOU AND YOUR SITUATION: Nehemiah reminds the Lord of His Word that applied specifically to their circumstance and people (8-10)
- F. THEN... <u>MAKE YOUR VERY SPECIFIC REQUEST</u> BE KNOWN TO GOD: Over much persistent prayer, God moved Nehemiah's heart to a very specific course of action, and he asked the Lord specifically (11)
