HOW CAN WE WHO ARE SO DIFFERENT WORK WELL TOGETHER? LEARNING FROM GOD'S PEOPLE WHO AROSE AND BUILT TOGETHER Nehemiah 3:1-32

- I. WE MUST BE WILLING TO DO HIS WILL, FOR GOD'S GLORY, BY HIS STRENGTH (2:17-18)
 - A. **We must have a common biblical goal:** Nehemiah communicated the common goal; build and repair the walls and gates
 - B. We must have a common purpose: Nehemiah communicated the purpose of the work; rebuild for God's glory
 - C. **We must rely completely on the Lord for success:** the only means of success was communicated: God's good hand upon them
- II. WE MUST BE WILLING TO DO THE WORK FROM THE HEART: "The people had a heart to work" (2:18, 4:6)
- **III.** WE MUST LET OUR LEADERS LEAD: Nehemiah exhibits extraordinary gifts of administration and organization, and the people follow (Ch. 3)

IV. WE MUST GET TO WORK (2:18, Ch. 3)

V. SOME INTERESTING OBSERVATIONS we can learn from (Ch. 3)

- A. Working together they each went about their individual assigned tasks (Ch. 3)
- B. The religious leaders set the example (3:1)

- E. Some did more work (3:5, 27; 18, 24)
- F. Some worked zealously (3:20)
