## HOW TO KEEP FROM BEING OVERCOME BY OUR ENEMIES' REPROACH RESISTING SATAN'S SCHEMES --- PART 1 Nehemiah 4:1-6

- I. <u>REALIZE SATAN USES PEOPLE TO TRY TO DISCOURAGE YOU</u> when you are doing the Lord's will: Sanballat, furious because the Jews were rebuilding, along with Tobiah, mock, despise and reproach the builders publicly (1-3)
  - A. Sanballat became furious and mocked the builders in public (1-2)
    - 1. You're too weak: 'Your feeble'
    - 2. You're too small to finish the task: 'Can you repair it yourselves?'
    - 3. Will your sacrifices cause the wall to be build: 'Will God whip this up out of thin air?
    - 4. The task is too great: 'Can you do it in a day?'
    - 5. You have too little to work with: 'Can stones be revived from heaps of dust or burnt stones?'
  - **B. Tobiah piles on...** 'What you've done so far is nothing', 'If a fox jumped on it, it would collapse' (3)

## II. <u>PRAY ABOUT THE SITUATION FROM THE RIGHT PERSPECTIVE</u>: Nehemiah shares the situation with the Lord and calls upon Him to bring just retribution upon their enemies (4-5)

- A. Nehemiah calls upon the Lord to hear how they are despised (4a)
- **B.** Nehemiah calls for the Lord's just retribution because their enemies have demoralized the builders (4b-5)

## III. <u>PERSEVERE IN THE LORD'S WORK FROM THE RIGHT HEART (6)</u>
