  - 1. From the beginning
  - 2. Until now
- II. PAUL ENCOURAGES THE PHILIPPIANS BY REVEALING HIS ABSOLUTE
  CONFIDENCE THAT GOD WILL COMPLETE THE GOOD WORK HE BEGAN
  IN THEM because they are sharers in the grace of God (6-8)
  - A. Paul is confident that God who began the good work will finish it (6)
    - 1. God began the good work (6a)
    - 2. God will complete (6b)
  - B. Why the confidence? It it is only right to for Paul to feel this way (7-8)
    - 1. Because they are co-sharers of the grace of God (7)
    - 2. Evidenced by a godly affection for them (8)
