HOW CAN WE HAVE JOY IN THE MIDST OF SUFFERING? LESSONS FROM PAUL'S RESPONSE TO SUFFERING Philippians 1:19-21a

I. REVIEW: WHEN WE SEE OUR SUFFERING AS A PLATFORM FOR THE GOSPEL, WE WILL HAVE JOY: Paul rejoiced because God used his difficult circumstances to advance the good news of Jesus to advance (12-18)

- II. WHEN WE KNOW THAT CHRIST WILL BE MAGNIFIED THROUGH OUR SUFFERING (if we are living for Him), WE WILL HAVE JOY: Paul rejoiced because he knew that God would answer prayers and empower him to speak of Jesus thus magnifying Christ whether he lives or dies (19-21)
 - A. Paul knew that he would be delivered from dishonoring Christ by the Philippians answered prayer for him through the Holy Spirit's provision (19-20a)

B. Paul was thus eagerly expecting and hoping that Christ would be magnified through him boldly and freely proclaiming Him (20)

C. The ultimate reason Paul could have such confidence: For him, to be living is Christ and to die is gain (21)
