MARKS OF A TRUE BELIEVER: PART 2 KNOWING CHRIST IS EVERYTHING Philippians 3:8

- I. REVIEW:
 - A. PAUL'S MINDSET BEFORE CHRIST: He had good earthly reason to be confident in the flesh (4-6)
 - B. PAUL'S MINDSET AT CONVERSION: All he saw in the past as religious gain or profit was counted as loss or damage for the sake of Christ (7)
- II. PAUL'S CURRENT MINDSET: For Paul nothing compares to gaining and thus truly knowing Christ (8-11)
 - A. Paul continually counted all as loss in view of surpassing value of knowing Christ, his Lord (8a)
 - 1. Nothing compares to truly knowing Christ Jesus the Lord
 - 2. For Christ Jesus, his Lord, Paul actually suffered total loss
 - B. Paul understood that what was lost needed to be considered as worthless refuge in order to gain Christ and the glorious benefits of a real relationship with Him (8b-11)
 - 1. Even further, Paul counts what was lost as worthless refuge... (8b)
 - 2. ... In order to gain Christ. (It is all about Him!!!) (8b)
