## THE SECRET OF CONTENTMENT THE ALL SUFFICIENCY OF CHRIST PHILIPPIANS 4:10-13

- I. THOSE WHO ARE TRULY CONTENT ARE NOT DRIVEN BY WANT, but rejoice in God's providential care through His Body (10-11a)
  - A. Paul's rejoices because of their flourishing concern for him (10a)
  - B. Paul understood true concern will be manifest when opportunity arises (10b)
  - C. Paul is not driven by his desires (11a)
- II. THOSE WHO ARE TRULY CONTENT, KNOW CONTENTMENT IS NOT BASED UPON CIRCUMSTANCE, BUT for the believer is LEARNED in the crucible of CIRCUMSTANCE: That is, Christ is all sufficient for every circumstance (11b-13)
  - A. Paul had learned in the crucible of circumstance to be content in any and all circumstances (11b- 12a)
    - 1. Paul had come to understand how to be content with humble means
    - 2. Paul had come to understand how to be content with an abundance
  - B. Paul learned the secret of contentment: CHRIST'S ALL SUFFICIENCY (12b-13)
