

“THE TOUR NO ONE WANTS TO TAKE”
WHAT THE LORD SEES Ezekiel 8-9

- I. EZEKIEL IS SHOWN THE TEMPLE ABOMINATIONS (Ch 8)**
 - A. The Lord powerfully takes Ezekiel to Jerusalem, and he is brought in the temple court, to the place of an abominable Idol (1-3)**

 - B. The Glory of God then reveals the temple abominations to Ezekiel (4-16)**
 - 1. The Glory of God, like at Chebar, shows Ezekiel the idol of jealousy (4-6)

 - 2. The Glory of God shows Ezekiel the elders idolatress worship (7-13)
 - a) A hole in the wall in the entrance of the court
 - b) The dark art of idolatry
 - c) They think the Lord does not see

 - 3. The Glory of God shows Ezekiel women weeping for Tammuz (14-15)

 - 4. The Glory of God shows Ezekiel the inner court abominations: Their backs turned, worshipping the sun (16)

 - C. The Glory of God reveals what He will do and why (17-18)**
 - 1. The reason reiterated (17)

 - 2. His wrath will be spent (18)

- II. EZEKIEL IS SHOWN WHAT GOD WILL DO IN RESPONSE (CH 9)**
 - A. Preparation for judgment (1-4)**
 - 1. The Lord summons the executioners (1-2)

 - 2. His Glory departs (3a)

 - 3. A remnant is marked to be spared (3b-4)

 - B. Judgment commanded and executed (5-7)**

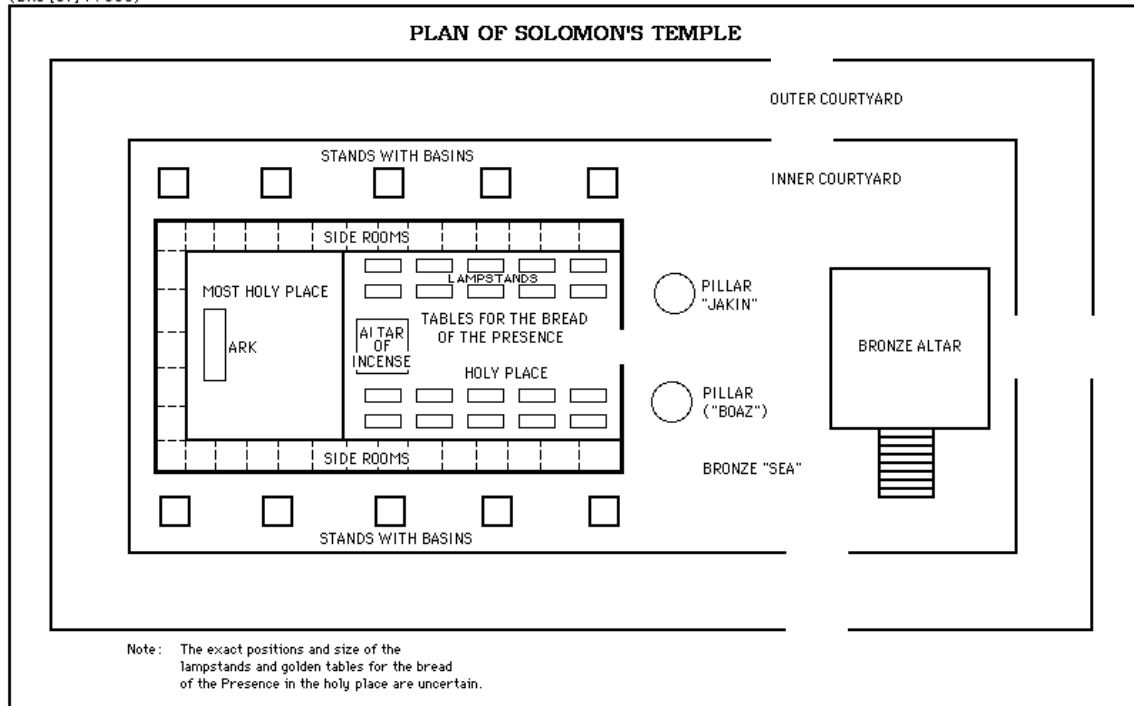
 - C. The reason for His judgment reiterated: Very, very great sin, no fear...they think the Lord doesn't see (8-11)**
