 - A. REBELLION BEGAN IN EGYPT (5-9)
 - 1. **God's Love displayed in Egypt:** Israel chosen, given His Word, and the Lord made known (5-7)
 - 2. **Israel's Response in Egypt:** They rebel against His Word (8a)
 - 3. God's Response to their rebellion in Egypt: (8b-9)
 - a) God resolves to destroy them, but His Judgment is stayed for His Name's Sake (8b-9a)
 - b) Israel delivered and God made known in the Exodus (9b)
 - B. REBELLION CONTINUED IN THE WILDERNESS (10-26)
 - 1. The father's rebellion in the wilderness (10-15)
 - a) God's Love displayed in the wilderness: Israel delivered, given His Word, that He would be made known (10-12)
 - b) **Israel's Response in the wilderness:** The father's rebelled against His Word (13a)
 - c) God's Response to their rebellion in the wilderness: (13b-16)
 - (1) God resolves to destroy them, but His judgment is stayed for His Name's Sake (13b-14)
 - (2) Discipline enacted against the fathers (15-17)
 - 2. The children's rebellion in the wilderness (18-26)
 - a) God's Love displayed in the wilderness: The children delivered, given His Word, that He would be made known (18-20)
 - b) **Israel's Response in the wilderness:** The children rebelled against His Word (21a)
 - c) God's Response to their rebellion in the wilderness: (21b-26)
 - (1) God resolves to destroy them, but Judgment is stayed for His Name's Sake (21b-22)
 - (2) Discipline enacted against the children; God made known (23-26)
