PRIDE COMES BEFORE FALL PROPHECY OF TYRE'S LEADER'S JUDGMENT Ezekiel 28:1-10

- I. EZEKIEL IS COMMANDED SPEAK GOD'S WORD TO THE LEADER OF TYRE (1-2a)
- II. THE REASON FOR HIS JUDGMENT: He made himself out to be God (2-6)
 - A. His extreme pride: He made himself out to be God (2a)
 - B. God 's response to his pride: You're a man not God (2b-5)
 - 1. You're a man regardless of what you think (2b)
 - 2. You think your wiser than Daniel and have it all figured out (3)
 - 3. You think your great wealth came through your great wisdom (4-5a)
 - 4. Yet great pride came from your riches (5b)
 - C. The ultimate reason for his judgment: He made his heart like God's (6)
- III. HIS JUDGMENT PROCLAIMED: He will be killed as a man (7-10)
 - **A.** God will bring ruthless nations upon him (7a)
 - **B.** They will destroy the beauty of his wisdom and defile his spender (7b)
 - **C.** They will kill him, and he will go to hell (8)
 - D. Being just a man, will he still say "I am a god," when he is being killed? No, He will die as a man, declares the Lord God (9-10)
