 - 1. Egypt and her helpers will fall by the sword (4-6)
 - 2. The results:
 - a) Her land and cities will be desolated (7)
 - b) They will know He is the Lord through judgment (8)
 - 3. The day will come (9)
- II. THE EXECUTION OF HIS JUDGMENTS ON THAT DAY DESCRIBED (10-19)
 - A. The means of the beginning of God's judgment upon Egypt: Nebuchadnezzar (10-11)
 - B. What God will do: How their pride will fall (12-18a)
 - 1. Their trusted irrigation system and the land will made desolate (12)
 - 2. Their cultic religious center Memphis will cease along with their proud Pharaoh (13a) (their gods or pharaoh can't help)
 - 3. Egypt's proud masses will fear (13b)
 - 4. Egypt's proud, sinful cities will be judged, Pathros, Zoan, Thebes, and Sin (14-15)
 - 5. The accompanying horror and anguish (16-18a)
 - C. The result: Her pride will fall in judgment (18b-19)
 - 1. "the pride of her power will cease in her" (18b)
 - 2. They will know He is the Lord through judgment (19)
