- I. Review: EZEKIEL REAPPOINTED A WATCHMAN (1-9)
- II. THE WATCHMAN'S DUTIES APPLIED, as Jerusalem's fall is imminent (10-20)
 - A. What to say to those who acknowledge God's judgment, but are unrepentant (10-11)
 - 1. Graciously confront their sinful thinking (10)
 - 2. Share God's desire for them to live from His Word (11a)
 - 3. Share God's command for them to repent from His Word (11b)
 - B. What to say to the self-righteous (12-16)
 - 1. Confront their sinful thinking with God's truth (12)
 - a) Your righteousness will not save you from your sin (12a)
 - b) Your previous sin will not stumble you when you repent (12b)
 - 2. Clearly relay the eternal consequences for their response to God's Word (13-16)
 - a) Trusting in your own righteousness is eternally deadly (13)
 - b) True repentance, exhibits righteous fruit and brings life (14-16)
 - C. What God says to those who cry foul, saying God is not fair (17-20)
 - 1. Confront their sinful thinking with God's truth (17-19)
 - 2. Get to the bottom line: You're personally responsible before God (20)
