- A. Ezekiel beholds God's glory coming from the east (1-2a)
- B. The vision described (2b-3a)
  - a) His voice and His radiance (2b)
  - b) It was like what Ezekiel saw when God came to destroy the city (3a)
  - c) It was like what He saw by the River Chebar (3a)
- C. EZEKIEL'S RESPONSE: He fell on his face (3b)
- II. THE GLORY OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST COMES INTO THE TEMPLE (4-5)
  - A. Glory of the Lord comes in through the east gate (4)
  - B. Ezekiel is lifted up and brought into the inner court by the Spirit (5a)
  - C. His glory fills the temple (5b)
- III. THE LORD OF GLORY SPEAKS TO EZEKIEL (6-12)
  - A. This is His dwelling place (6-7a)
  - B. Israel will no longer defile His Holy Name (7b-9)
  - C. Ezekiel commanded to describe it to the exiles (10-12)
    - a) ...so that they will be ashamed (10)
    - b) ...so that they will obey (11-12)
